DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

1. EXECUTIVE MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (18 Months)

The programme has a minimum duration of 18 months (3 Semesters). The programme is designed to meet the needs of students through lectures, seminars, workshops, case studies, individual and group works, tutorials, and practical sessions.

Lectures are designed to be delivered in a flexible fashion that include face to face sessions with the blend of online lecture delivery that allows the busy schedule of a typical busy Nigerian working Business Executive.

Candidates applying for admission for MBA must possess five O' Level Credit passes including English Language and Mathematics, at not more than two sittings. In addition, candidates must have a First degree not less than Second Class (Lower Division) in any discipline from any institution recognized by the University Senate. Candidates who possess Postgraduate Diploma in any discipline from any recognized institution may also be considered for admission.

2. POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION –1 Academic Session (2Semesters)

The Postgraduate Diploma in Management (PGD Business Administration) is designed to serve as a feeder to Master in Business Administration Programme (MBA) and higher professional degree programme such as Doctor of Business Administration (DBA). The PGD Business Administration will provide students without university honours degree, those with Third Class B.Sc. degree, Higher National Diploma, and those willing to change field, with the opportunity to advance careers in the field of management. In essence the programme seeks to improve manpower in the academia and industry.

To be admitted for the Postgraduate Diploma in Business Administration Programme, a candidate must possess:

- i. A minimum of Third Class degree in Business Administration and or any of its specialized areas Management, Marketing, Human Resources Management, Financial Management-, Accounting, Economics, Finance, or any other Social Science discipline.
- ii. A minimum of Second Class (Honours) degree for applicants from other programmes not mentioned in (i) above.
- iii. Candidates who possess HND with Lower Credit in Business Administration or any one of the other relevant courses listed in (i) above may also be considered for admission to undertake the programme.

3. CERTIFICATE IN STRATEGIC PROCUREMENT AND CONTRACT MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

Strategic Procurement and Contract Management is designed for Procurement Managers, Supply Chain Administrative Managers of banks, and Public Sector Companies, Accounts and Finance, Travel and Tourism, Airline, Hospital Managers, and Procurement Officers.

The Certificate programme is packaged to enhance capacity-building among executives and professionals in specific skills of procurement management.

Candidates seeking admission to this programme shall possess University degree, HND or ND from recognized institutions.

4. CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME IN LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

Certificate in Logistics and Supply Chain Management is designed for Professionals from various organizations like Accounts and Finance, Travel and Tourism, Airline, Hospital

Managers, and Procurement Officers. The Certificate Programme is packaged to enhance capacity building among executives and professionals in specific skills of supply chain bottleneck.

Candidates must possess First degree or HND from recognized institutions.

DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY AND PLANNING SCIENCES

1. MASTER IN ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT (18 Months)

The Master of Science degree programme in Environmental Management (MEM) runs for 18 months. The first year shall contain two semesters of coursework while the Second semester shall involve an industrial attachment and writing of the MEM research project.

Candidates seeking admission to the MEM programme in the Department of Geography and Planning Sciences shall be graduates of Geography and Planning Sciences, Urban and Regional Planning, Biological and Environmental Sciences or Geology or any other related discipline of the Adekunle Ajasin University, Akungba-Akoko or other universities recognized by the Senate of Adekunle Ajasin University, Akungba-Akoko. In addition, candidates in relevant disciplines who hold any of the following academic qualifications shall be eligible for admission: (i) The Royal Society for the promotion of Health Inspectors, West Africa on Salary Grade Level 12 and above who have at least 10 years cognate experience; (ii) WAHAB with other conditions under (i) above; and (iii) Higher National Diploma (HND) in Health/Environmental Management. All candidates must possess five (5) Credit passes including English Language and any other four subjects at the Ordinary Level (OL) WAEC/NECO/ NABTEB or GCE or its equivalent at not more than two sittings.

2. CERTIFICATE IN CLIMATE CHANGE AND DISASTER MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

The programme on offer is Certificate in Climate Change and Disaster Management (CDM). The duration of the award of a Certificate in Climate Change and Disaster Management shall be six (6) months.

Candidates seeking admission to the Certificate Programme in Climate and Disaster Management (CDM) must possess five (5) Credit passes in English Language and any other four subjects at the Ordinary Level (OL)/ General Certificate of Education (GCE) or its equivalent at not more than two sittings.

3. CERTIFICATE IN TRANSPORTATION AND LOGISTICS MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

The programme on offer is Certificate in Transportation and Logistics Management. The duration of award of a certificate in this programme shall be six (6) months.

Candidates seeking admission to the 6 months programme must have obtained Credit passes in English language and any other four (4) O' Level subjects (WAEC/NECO/ NABTEB/GCE) at not more than two sittings, plus Trade Test I,II and III.

4. CERTIFICATE IN ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT (6 months)

The programme on offer is a Certificate in Environmental Management. The duration of the award of a certificate in this programme shall be six (6) months.

Candidates seeking admission to the Certificate Programme in Environmental Management must possess five (5) Credit passes in English Language and any other four (4) subjects at the Ordinary Level (OL)/ General Certificate of Education (GCE) or its equivalent at not more than two sittings.

DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

1. EXECUTIVE MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE AND ANALYTICS (18 Months)

Admission Requirements

In addition to possessing Credit passes in English, Mathematics and three other subjects at not more than two sittings in WAEC, NECO, NABTEB or equivalent, qualified candidates must hold either a Bachelor's Degree with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) in any discipline from a recognized University or educational institution recognized by the Senate or a Postgraduate Diploma in any discipline with an overall minimum average score of 60% or equivalent. However, applicants with adequate experience in Data Management, Database Administration, Information Technology, or equivalent who hold other higher qualifications approved by the Senate may be considered for admission. In addition, a letter of recommendation from employer may be required.

2. EXECUTIVE MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND SOFTWARE PROJECT MANAGEMENT (18 Months)

Admission Requirements

In addition to possessing Credit passes in English, Mathematics and three other subjects at no more than two sittings in WAEC, NECO, NABTEB or equivalent, qualified candidates must hold either a Bachelor's Degree with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) in any discipline from a recognized University or educational institution recognized by the Senate or a Postgraduate Diploma in any discipline with an overall minimum average score of 60% or equivalent. However, applicants with adequate experience in Information Technology, Programming, Software Engineering or equivalent who hold other higher qualifications approved by the Senate may be considered for admission. In addition, a letter of recommendation from employer may be required.

3. CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME IN DATA MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

Admission Requirements

In addition to possessing Credit passes in English, Mathematics and three other subjects at not more than two sittings in WAEC, NECO, NABTEB or equivalent, qualified candidates must possess experience in Data Management, Data Processing, Information Technology or equivalent. In addition, a letter of recommendation from employer may be required.

4. CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME IN CYBER SECURITY MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

Admission Requirements

In addition to possessing Credit passes in English, Mathematics and three other subjects at no more than two sittings in WAEC, NECO, NABTEB or equivalent qualified candidates must possess experience in Network Administration, Information Technology, Cybersecurity or equivalent. In addition, a letter of recommendation from employer may be required.

DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND FINANCE

1. MASTER'S IN FINANCE (18 Months)

Admission Requirements

Intending candidates for admission to the Master's degree in Finance programme must possess Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects in WASSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or NECO in English Language, Mathematics, and any other three subjects. Subject combinations must not be more than two sittings. A minimum Bachelor's degree Second Class (Lower Division) in Finance, Banking and Finance, Accounting, Economics, or Business Administration obtained from Adekunle Ajasin University or any other University recognized by the Senate is also required and acceptable.

2. CERTIFICATE IN RISK MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

Admission Requirements

Intending candidates for admission into the Certificate in Risk Management programme are expected to possess Credit passes in at least five (5) relevant subjects in WASSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or NECO in English Language, Mathematics, and any other three subjects. Subject combinations must not be at more than two sittings. Graduates of Finance and other related courses such as Accounting, Economics, Business Administration, etc. who are interested in the Certificate programme, are all also eligible to apply.

3. CERTIFICATE IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT (6 Months)

Admission Requirements

Intending candidates for admission into the Certificate in Project Management Programme should possess Credit passes in at least five (5) relevant subjects in WASSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or NECO in English Language, Mathematics, and any other three subjects at not more than two sittings. Applicants with proven work experience with at least four (4) Credit passes, including Mathematics and English may be considered for admission. Graduates of Finance and other related courses such as Accounting, Economics, Business Administration, etc, who are interested in the Certificate programme are all also eligible to apply.

4. CERTIFICATE IN TREASURY MANAGEMENT

(6 Months)

Admission Requirements

Intending candidates for admission to Certificate in Treasury Management Programme should possess Credit passes in at least five (5) relevant subjects in WASSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or NECO in English Language, Mathematics, and any other three subjects at not more than two sittings. Applicants with proven work experience with at least four Credit passes, including Mathematics and English may be considered for admission. Graduates of Finance and other related courses such as Accounting, Economics, Business Administration, etc. who are interested in the Certificate programme, are all also eligible to apply.

5. CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF BANKERS TRAINING PROGRAMME (6 Months)

Admission Requirements

Intending candidates for admission into the Chartered Institute of Bankers Training Programme should possess Credit passes in at least five (5) relevant subjects in WASSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or NECO in English Language, Mathematics, and any other three subjects at not more than two sittings. Graduates of Finance and other related courses such as Accounting, Economics, Business Administration, etc. as well as others in any field are also eligible to apply.

DEPARTMENT OF MASS COMMUNICATION

CERTIFICATE IN CRISIS COMMUNICATION AND MANAGEMENT FOR MANAGERS (6 Months)

Admission Requirements

Candidates for admission to the Certificate in Crisis Communication and Management for managers must have a first degree in any Social or Management Sciences discipline and should possess in addition, a Senior Secondary School Certificate or General Certificate of Education or

West African Examination Council (WAEC) or National Examination Council (SSCE-WAEC/NECO) or their equivalent with at least five Credit passes, including English Language, Mathematics and Government, at not more than two sittings.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

1. EXECUTIVE MASTER'S IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION (18 Months)

Prospective candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree in any field of The Social Sciences, Administration, Management, Pure/Natural Sciences, Arts, Education, Medical, Engineering, etc. with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) from institutions recognized by the Senate of this University. Similarly, Postgraduate Diploma holders in Public Administration or any Management and Social Science courses (with minimum of Upper Credit) in the aforementioned disciplines may also be admitted for the programme.

In addition, candidates must have five (5) O 'Level Credits passes in WASCE/SSSCE/GCE/NABTEB/NECO which must include English Language and Mathematics, from any class of subjects at not more than two sittings.

2. EXECUTIVE POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

(1 Academic Session)

The candidates must also hold Higher Diploma or similar professional qualifications with minimum of Lower Credit in any discipline in the Social Sciences, Management, Pure/Applied Sciences, Arts and Education, Medical, Engineering etc. from any institution recognized by the Senate of Adekunle Ajasin University Akungba Akoko.

In addition, the candidates must have 5 O'level subjects in WASCE/SSCE/GCE/NABTEB/NECO which must include English Language and any other three subjects at not more than two sittings.

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, POLICY AND STRATEGIC STUDIES (PGDPAPSS) – 1 Academic Session

Admission Requirements

Candidates seeking admission to Postgraduate Diploma in Public Administration, Policy and Strategic Studies (PGDPAPSS) in the Department of Public Administration must have Credit passes in five (5) O'Level subjects in WASCE/SSCE/GCE/NABTEB/NECO, which must include English Language and Mathematics, at not more than two sittings in any course such as Commercial, Social Science, Management, Pure and Applied Sciences.

The candidates must hold a certificate such as Higher Diploma or similar professional qualifications with minimum of Lower Credit in any discipline such as Social Sciences, Management, Pure and Applied Sciences, Arts and Education, Medical, Engineering, etc. from any institution recognized by the University Senate of Adekunle Ajasin University Akungba Akoko.

DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING

EXECUTIVE MASTER'S IN FORENSIC ACCOUNTING (18 Months)

Candidates admitted to the Executive Master in Forensic Accounting shall possess a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) in Accounting from Adekunle Ajasin University or any other recognized University. In addition, they must possess Credit passes in five (5) subjects, including English language, Mathematics and any other three subjects.

Those with at least Lower Credit in Higher National Diploma (HND) are eligible for admission. Holders of professional qualifications in Accounting will also be considered for admission. A professional qualification in Accounting will be taken to mean an Associate member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria ICAN, ANAN, CITN or any other equivalent body. In exceptional cases, candidates with at least Second Class (Lower Division) in any social science, or Accounting Education, or Management science or science related discipline, may be considered, provided such candidate must make up for the deficiencies in core accounting courses at the Undergraduate level. Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in an oral interview or written examination or both prior to admission. Candidates with a Third Class in Accounting plus a Postgraduate Diploma in Accounting, Forensic Accounting or Taxation not below 60% average are eligible.

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES

1. Certificate in Tax Management: (6 Months)

Admission requirements: Possession of at least Second Class (Lower) degree or Lower Credit in Higher National Diploma in the field of Accounting, Finance and Business Administration. Possession of professional certificate such as ICAN and ACCA will be an added advantage.

2. Certificate in Budgeting (6 Months)

Admission Requirements: At least, possession of Ordinary National Diploma or NCE in the field of Accounting and related disciplines.

3. Certificate in Treasury Management (6 Months)

Admission requirements: Possession of at least Second Class (Lower Division) degree or Lower Credit in Higher National Diploma in the field of Accounting, Finance, Banking and Business Administration. Possession of professional certificates in Accounting, Finance, Insurance and Banking will be an added advantage.

4. Certificate in Risk Management (6 Months)

Admission requirements: Possession of at least Second Class (Lower Division) degree or Lower Credit in Higher National Diploma in the field of Accounting, Finance and Business

Administration. Possession of professional certificate such as ICAN or ACCA is an added advantage.

5. Certificate in Forensic Accounting (DURATION – 6 Months)

Possession of at least Second Class (Lower) degree or Lower Credit in Higher National Diploma in the field of Accounting, Finance and Business Administration. Possession of professional certificates such as ICAN, ANAN and CITN will be an added advantage.

DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

EXECUTIVE MASTER'S IN POLITICAL SCIENCE (18 Months)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must possess Credit passes in five (5) O' Level subjects in English Language, Mathematics, Government/History and two other Social Science/Arts subjects (e.g. Economics, Civics and Geography). In addition, candidates should possess at least a First degree in Political Science, Public Administration, Human Resources Management, International Relations, Strategic Studies, Economics, History, Industrial and Labour Relations, Public Sector Management, Philosophy or any other related discipline, with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division). Candidates who hold a Third Class in first degree, but who possess Postgraduate Diploma in Political Science of this institution or any institution recognized by the Senate of Adekunle Ajasin University, may also be considered for admission.

SHORT TERM (CERTIFICATE) PROGRAMME IN THE FOLLOWING COURSES:

Candidates shall hold good honours Bachelor's degree in any discipline of the Adekunle Ajasin University or other recognized Universities. Applicants who possess Higher National Diploma (at least Lower Credit) and with Postgraduate Diploma in any discipline may be considered for admission.

Candidates shall also possess, at least, three Ordinary Level Credit passes in WASC, WAEC SSCE/GCE, NECO SSCE. The subjects should include English Language, Mathematics, Government, Economics, History and any other Social Science subject.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

MASTER'S IN TAXATION AND PUBLIC FINANCE (18 Months)

Admission Requirements:

Applicants should possess five (5) Credit passes in relevant subjects obtained in not more than two sittings at SSCE, GCE Ordinary Level, or its equivalent. The subjects must include English Language, Mathematics, Economics, one Social Science and any other subject. In addition, the candidate must possess Bachelor's degree or Higher National Diploma (HND) in Economics, Statistics, Economics and Statistics, Banking and Finance, Finance, Business Administration, Public Administration, Political Science with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) or relevant professional qualifications such as, ACA, CITN with years of experience in Tax Practice. Candidates may be required to satisfy the Business School in an oral interview or written examination or both prior to admission.

CERTIFICATE IN INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND FINANCE (6 Months)

Admission requirements:

Applicants should have a minimum of five (5) Credit passes in relevant subjects obtained in not more than two sittings in SSCE, GCE Ordinary Level, or its equivalent. The subjects must include English Language, Mathematics, Economics, one Social Science and any other subject. In addition the candidate must possess Bachelor's degree or Higher National Diploma (HND) in

Economics, Statistics, Economics and Statistics, Law, Banking and Finance, Finance, Business Administration, Purchasing and Supply Management, Project Management, Civil Engineering with a minimum of Third Class Division or evidence of any degree certificate or relevant professional qualifications such as ACA, CIBN, CIS. Candidates may be required to satisfy the Business School in an oral interview or written examination or both prior to admission.
